



Telephone Number Bingo

Items Included in This Activity

15 individual cards

1 Bingo card 5X5

1 Bingo card 3X3

Instructions

Level: Beginning to lower intermediate

Language skills: Speaking and listening

Language focus: Numbers and contractions

Instructions:

Print, make copies of, and cut out the individual cards. Print and make copies of the bingo card. For small class (under 25 students) you should use the 3X3 card. For classes of 26 or more use the 5X5 card. Make enough copies so that each student has one individual card and one bingo card.

First, pass out the individual cards to your students. Tell them to write their phone number on the card and then to fold the card in half. Collect the cards from the students and then pass out the bingo cards. Each student should get only one bingo card.

Now tell the students to walk around and ask for the phone numbers of their classmates using the question,

"What's your phone number?"

They should answer, "My number's _____." filling in the blank with their phone number.

Example:

Student A: What's your phone number?

Student B: My phone number's 555-1213.

As student B says his or her phone number, student A should write the number in one of the boxes on the bingo card. Students should exchange phone numbers with different students until all the boxes on the bingo card has a number in it.

After all the students have filled in all the boxes on their bingo cards and returned to their seats, the teacher will begin the bingo game.

Randomly draw phone numbers from the individual cards collected earlier and read each phone number aloud. Give students enough time between numbers to be able to scan their bingo card to see if the number is on their card. If the number read is on a student's card, the student should check the box with the number in it. The first student to check 5 numbers in a row wins the bingo game.
