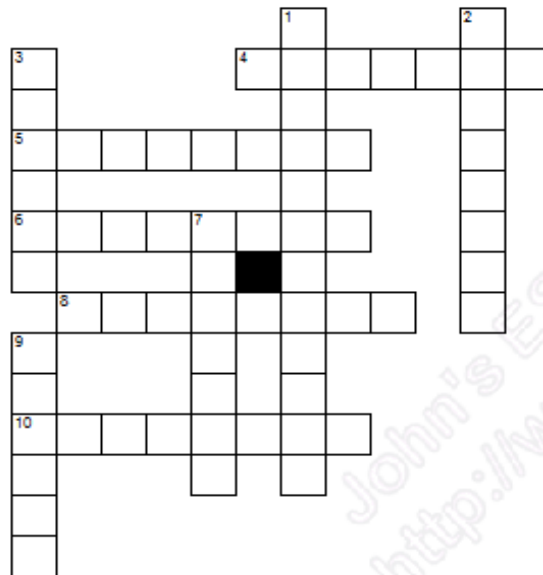


## Bodies of Water



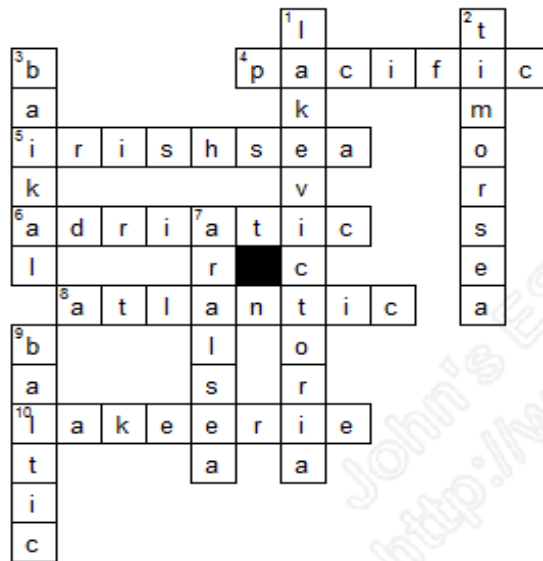
### Across
