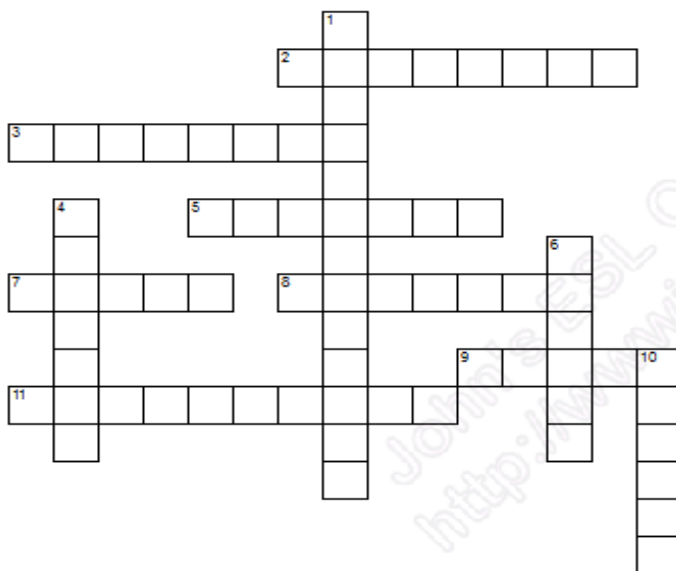


Rooms in a House



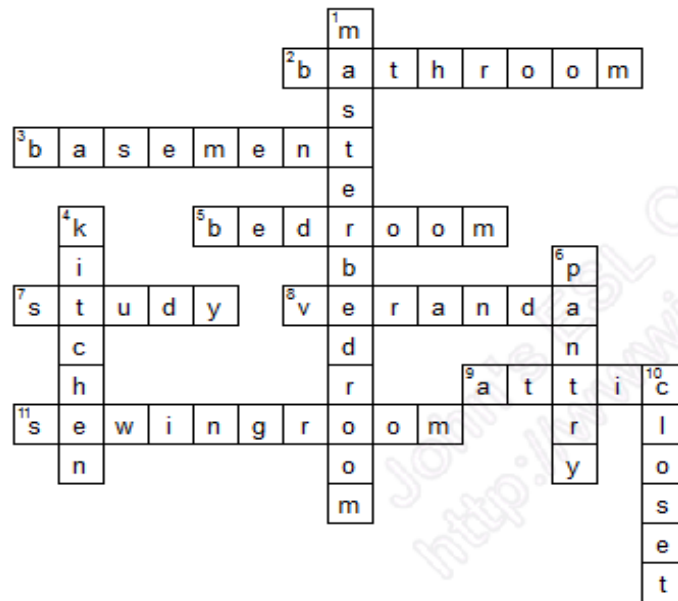
Across
